SUBJECT: Rulemaking—animals in electrolysis offices

Attached to this memo are two rules for the board to propose through the permanent rulemaking process. The board will consider the rules at its October 24, 2023 meeting.

The rules would prohibit animals in electrolysis offices, except for service dogs and office aquariums. The rules would also establish a schedule of civil penalties for offices that allow prohibited animals. The rules are modeled after similar rules for barber shops and mobile barber shops.

BOARD ACTION AND FUTURE STEPS

- 1. If the board wishes to adopt the rules, it will propose them at the October 24, 2023 meeting.
- 2. After publication in the North Carolina Register, a 60-day comment period will begin.
- 3. After the comment period, the board will review any public comments and decide whether it wishes to adopt the rules.
- 4. If adopted, the Rules Review Commission will determine whether to approve them.
